Sacred Hearts School is committed to teaching and living Catholic Values, striving for academic excellence, and providing extra curricular programs achieved in partnership with a dedicated faculty, motivated students, concerned parents and a supportive parish community. Sacred Hearts School recognizes and respects the uniqueness of each child and encourages students to develop morally, academically, and socially. Students are challenged to become critical thinkers who are self confident, self disciplined, respectful of the world around them, and firmly committed to living a faith-filled life.

SACRED HEARTS SCHOOL PHILOSOPHY

We believe that:

- Sacred Hearts School exists to carry out its mission of teaching God's message of salvation and of preparing students for a life of service in a Christian Community of Faith.
- Sacred Hearts School integrates religion with learning and living and emphasizes values needed for a life of Christian fulfillment.
- Students are individuals with their own cultural backgrounds and needs. Students develop self-discipline, a healthy self-image, and responsibility in a structured environment with positive reinforcement.
- Sacred Hearts prepares students to further their education by providing a firm foundation of basic skills, to think creatively, to express themselves without fear and to assume responsibility and leadership in a life of service to God and others.

ADMISSION POLICY TO SACRED HEARTS SCHOOL

Children seeking admission to Sacred Hearts School will be required to register in late December to early February. Admission priority to Sacred Hearts School is as follows:

1. Siblings of Current Students
2. Current Students of the Sacred Hearts Children's Center
3. Child of Parishioner* not currently enrolled
4. Child of Non-Parishioner

* See Parishioner as defined in the 2010-2011 Covenant of Support.

COVENANT OF SUPPORT

Upon acceptance, each family is required to sign and fulfill the Covenant of Support. The Covenant for the current year is:

Terms of the Covenant FOR PARISHIONERS* 2010-2011

1. The Family is registered at Sacred Hearts Parish, worships weekly at Sacred Hearts Parish and contributes a minimum of \$400 to the Parish via the weekly Offertory Envelope.
2. The Family pays Full Tuition commensurate with the Tuition Scale for the current year. Payment options available, but must be paid in full by June 30th.
3. The Family is responsible for purchasing/selling twenty (20) School Raffle Calendars at \$10 each. The total amount of \$200 is due by December 20th.
4. At least one parent/guardian of the Family volunteers 20 HOURS OF SERVICE. (List of possible volunteer opportunities is published in the Events & Activities Guide that is published at the beginning of the school year.) A family may choose to waive the 20 hours and pay \$400 in lieu of volunteering. If so, payment in full is due by October 1st. Note: Families who choose to volunteer, but do not fulfill their 20 hours will be billed at a rate of \$20 per missing hours.
5. The Family makes a \$150 contribution to the Spring Fundraiser. The total is due by March 1st.

*Terms of the **Covenant FOR NON-PARISHIONERS 2010-2011** is differentiated by the cost which is an **additional \$400**).

ALL OTHER TERMS OF THE NON-PARISHIONER COVENANT ARE THE SAME AS THOSE STATED ABOVE FOR PARISHIONER.

TUITION PAYMENT OPTION LIST

Option 1 – Full tuition due July 1, 2010.

Option 2 – Two equal payments: first payment due July 1st; second payment due December 1st.

Option 3 – F.A.C.T.S. Automatic Monthly payment. Payments budgeted over 10 months beginning in August. Payments may not extend beyond the month of May.

Note: Payment Option Preference must be communicated to the Office by May of the upcoming school year.
